Nettleton's distinctive inspection initials using the exact fonts, placements, and proof marks found on the originals.

Chambered in .45 Colt, the Henry Nettleton Cavalry model features a 7 ½-inch barrel, standard blue finish, and walnut grips. What sets this firearm apart is its extraordinary historical accuracy. In 1878, Nettleton inspected and stamped approximately 3,000 pistols, uniquely placing his inspection marks on the left side of the hammer and trigger guard, an anomaly among U.S. Ordnance inspectors that remains unexplained to this day. Cimarron's recreation pays tribute to these scarce government-issued firearms, preserving the defining details that made them the weapon of choice for U.S. Cavalry troops.
